

Questions You May Have...





Q: Who is the next Master?

A: This is not known until Sri Harold makes the announcement.

Q: What will be the title of the new Master?

A: The MAHANTA, the Living ECK Master.

Q: Will the new Master also serve as the Inner Master?

A: Yes—the Inner and Outer Master are two different aspects of one being—the MAHANTA, the Living ECK Master.

Q: What is the difference between a MAHANTA, the Living ECK Master of the Twelfth Circle of initiation and one of the Fourteenth Circle?

A: A Fourteenth Initiate comes every 5 to 1,000 years to usher in a major age of spiritual unfoldment. The timing depends upon spiritual need. The group entity of all Souls in all worlds determines that need.

Note: Your initiations are your own responsibility and have no bearing upon whether your Master is of the Twelfth or Fourteenth Circle.

Q: Are any announcements about this historic event wanted at ECK events, Vahana presentations, etc?
